2: ECNP Network Proposal

We can submit a full proposal. Barbara will make a final draft and will send it to all IMpACT members for approval.

3: Horizon 2020, PHC3 call → update (Andreas)

Preliminary proposal will be sent to all members. Gaps have to be filled in by all IMpACT members. Contact person for Ipsych is Steve, Jonna contact person by Finnish registry, but we need to decide whether these can really have added value to what Henrik can provide. Commercial participants will not be strictly necessary for this project but would not be harmful. The meeting in Frankfurt in the summer will be probably on July 28th.

4: IMpACT database

For the database Janneke has received extra information from Germany. In the week of 19th of May Janneke will send out the new freeze of the database. We will check in August if there is enough reason to update the database again to implement e.g. additional German samples.

5: Ongoing projects

- A. Exome chip: The Dutch site will be ready in 2 weeks with genotyping of the Dutch and Brazilian samples. The others are almost ready.
- B. GWAS –Spain: The last version of the manuscript has been sent to all members. Next Monday, 12th of May, is the deadline for sending in the comments.
- C. Meta-analyses: DRD5 ongoing, NOS1 meta-analysis nearly finished.
- D. Others: 5HTT study proposed by Barbara. However, there is little life event data in the IMpACT cohorts.
