Suggestion is to include data from Ben Neale, he has already done a replication. But this is done in Childhood. For replication, adult ADHD samples are preferable but the next best option is childhood samples.

Tetyana will make a proposal with the samples to be analysed and people can send their remarks/ suggestions or add extra samples and send them to her.

Brazilian samples are genotyped in Broad but not yet in Bergen, Spain data are already in Bergen.
