### 2. Update from ongoing projects:

- a. *ODD/CD paper (Jan)*  
Currently busy with revision of the paper. Tetyana coordinates the genetic part.
- b. *Exome chip paper (Jan)*  
Exome chip paper is almost finished. The question is how to connect the findings with the ADHD-BPD overlap paper of Alejandro/Andreas. This paper

is also being finished. The contact with the PGC Bipolar group is difficult. The group of Andreas need to do some bioinformatic work. Tetyana has sent an email to Philip for the Materials and Methods part, but has not received a response yet. She will also send an email to Lena.

c. *Personality analysis (Toni, Claiton)*

d. *DRD5 meta-analysis (Barbara)*

*Marieke Klein has analysed the DRD5 results with and without the USA samples. The sample size from the USA was very small, this created a HWE problem. Stefan asks if they can check the genotypes again to be sure that the coding is correct. Marieke will send Stefan the data. Marieke will check the frequency counts again to make sure that the alleles called in the same way for every country.*

DRD5 has no effect on adult ADHD in contrast with the meta-analysis done on children. Write this up as a short letter. Plan b: to look if DRD5 has a persistent effect on brain structure.

e. *LPHN3 meta-analysis Arcos-Burgos group (Barbara)*

The IMPACT group is willing to cooperate. Barbara will also ask if it is possible for every lab to do the analysis themselves so that nobody has to send data; we will be included as co-authors.

f. *Proposal: shared/specific genetic basis of ADHD and ASD (Bru)*

Steve and Bru are co-supervising a PhD student who is working on the shared/specific genetic basis of ADHD and ASD, using the PGC data. Their focus will be on specific groups of genes (mainly microRNAs, mitochondria and endosome trafficking). They have already produced a list of SNPs covering all microRNAs in the genome (>1500) and are waiting to gain formal access to the PGC data. Until this happens, they would like to run a 'pilot project' by testing these microRNA SNPs in adult ADHD data. In Barcelona, Marta and Toni have around 1000 GWASed cases and 1000 controls.

Who would like to join? Not everybody can send raw data. Is it possible to distribute a protocol and let the analysis be done by each group, just send the summary statistics. Bru will discuss this and send a list of the miRNAs.

### **3. Update on internet-based testing (plans with budget ECNP Network)**

A part of the money within the ECNP Network will be used for a manager. The task of this manager will be to help us with making decisions regarding selection of the questionnaires and tasks for internet based testing and the translation of the instruments. Marten Onnink will be appointed as manager, if the budget is approved.
