2. Update projects

2a. Progress adult ADHD GWAS MA (Marta)

- QC is done for all samples, no additional data necessary. Finalizing imputation and harmonization of one last dataset now. Summary statistics for meta-analysis will be sent in the following weeks.
- Update on the childhood vs. adulthood PGC approved proposal: including the analysis of the children samples is next. This step is difficult to set-up, because we need information about remitters and persistence of ADHD.
- Is it possible to start a new project following up childhood samples of ADHD, who are now in adulthood in order to really evaluate remission/persistence and perform this on a large

scale? This is an enormous amount of work but perhaps worth the effort. Worthwhile to investigate the possibilities during the IMpACT meeting in May.

2b. Epigenetics (Tetyana)

- Marta is a bit worried that there should be no overlap with other studies that are being carried out by 2 students from their group. The MiND project will overlap the IMpACT project, but in order to avoid that, Tetyana suggests we could start with the parent of origin proposal.
- Barbara: In Nijmegen a epigenetic study is set up with target sequencing. We don't know yet if the quality is good enough. Barbara has also a cooperation with Amsterdam on adult ADHD symptoms (N= ~2000 individuals). They are looking for a replication cohort for this study.
- Illumina has offered reduced rates for an epigenetic chip (EPIC chip= 850K). Norway is interested.

2c others
