2. Project proposal Nicoletta Adamo: Study on remitters from ADHD, Nicoletta

Nicoletta is studying remission in ADHD using samples from the UK and from The Netherlands. However, she is left with very few cases when excluding siblings. Therefore, she is looking for suggestions of other samples available that could be included in this study.

She has plans to submit this study idea as a fellowship proposal (eg. VENI, Wellcome Trust, others suitable for clinicians). Andreas finds the topic interesting and thinks the exact proposal needs to be discussed on greater detail. Nicoletta will discuss it further with her supervisors and get back to the group when she has a more clear proposal.

Alejandro states that the results are not very promising - PGC 0.06 (no-window), 0.09 (100kb). So he thinks they should decide what to do and “get done with it”.

b. NEO-neuroticism genes, Andreas

Andreas’ group has been looking into the genetics of neuroticism (NEO) in adults with ADHD. He is now gathering information on datasets with personality data available within IMpACT sites.

Andreas asked the Dutch group to check updated number of samples with genomic and personality data available. Marieke found out that there are in fact 110 individuals with ADHD in the IMpACT-NL sample that have GWAS+personality data.

5. Evaluation 10-year Anniversary meeting IMpACT

Only positive comments were made for this point, such as: “Nothing to discuss about it: It was just great!!”; “Barbara isn’t on the call so we could praise her.” and “It was a wonderful meeting.”

6. Others

a. EU grants

Sites other than Nijmegen-Frankfurt should step in and coordinate project proposals of EU grants.

At least 3 contact points should lobby for ADHD work to be included in the call of mental health in the workplace. Modification on July (people will let Andreas know). Official proposal on September or October.

Regarding the Comorbidity call - Alejandro things it's not the time to apply for microbiome again now.
